Non-Insured Health Benefits (NIHB)

Nation-wide program that provides health benefits coverage for eligible First Nations and Inuit people that are not covered by social programs, private insurance plans, and/or provincial or territorial health insurance.

Covers: vision, dental, mental health counselling, medical supplies and equipment, prescriptions, and medical transportation to services not available in the community of residence.
